"CUB site

The Friends of the Carlton United Site (FoCUS) is a single issue community group, formed specifically to get a better outcome both socially and environmentally for the CUB site.

Recently legal action was taken by a local resident challenging the Minister's decision. This is being done to get a more acceptable environmental outcome. We are advised that there is a better than 50% chance of success based on the Anvill Hill precedent, however believe this can only be achieved through community support.

A committee is being formed to concentrate on the legal challenge. Their role will be to keep the broader community informed and involved, to arrange community meetings and communicate to the media as well as organise activities to assist in funding the legal challenge.
